Marriage	Dominican Republic	Constitution, Article 55.	No

The Dominican Republic recognizes two forms of marriage: civil marriage, performed by a government official, and canonical marriage, performed by a Roman Catholic priest. Neither type is available to same-sex couples because the Constitution of the Dominican Republic limits marriage to one man and one woman.
